“EMBROIDERING WITH SPECIALTY FRAMES”



Baby Lock’s specialty frames were designed to allow you to easily embroider hard-to-hoop items. The following projects are just a few of the endless items you can embroider with designs and custom logos to offer to your customers.

Tote Bag and Purse Frames:



Supplies:

Baby Lock Embroidery Professional embroidery machine
Baby Lock Great Outdoors design collection BLDP-P30
Extra Large Tote Bag and Purse Frame
Designer’s Gallery CustomWorks
Designer’s Gallery LetterWorks
Purchased sweatshirt
Baby Lock Cut-Away stabilizer
Various colors of embroidery thread

Instructions:

1. Select a design from the Baby Lock design collection.



2. Open CustomWorks. Click on the LetterWorks text tabs. Add personalization of you team or group name and other group identity such as number or team motto. Re-size the main design if necessary to accommodate the lettering.
3. Save the design and transfer it to your embroidery machine using your preferred method (i.e. memory card, floppy disk, direct transfer or flash drive).
4. Make a template of the design by using the computer to print an actual size pattern (Note: design software such as Designer's Gallery CustomWorks is needed) or stitch the design on extra fabric for use as a template. You will use the template to check the size and placement of the design on the garment.
5. Hoop Cut-Away stabilizer in the tote bag frame. Lightly mist the stabilizer with temporary machine spray adhesive. This hoop is designed to easily slide into pre-made items such as tote bags and garments without requiring the garment to be disassembled. Hoop the sweatshirt with the base of the sweatshirt towards the "w" shaped brackets. Remember to center the desired design placement area within the embroidery field.
6. Embroider the design using your favorite embroidery thread colors.
7. Once the embroidery design is complete, remove it from the hoop, trim away the excess stabilizer.

Advanced Cap Frame:



Supplies:

Baby Lock Embroidery Professional Embroidery Machine
Advanced Cap Frame Set (EPCF3)
Purchased caps

Baby Lock Cut-Away stabilizer
Various colors of embroidery thread



Instructions:

8. Attach the cap frame driver to the machine (refer to the instruction manual for assistance). Once the cap frame driver is attached the machine will recognize and display the cap frame embroidery field.
9. Select built-in lettering from the Baby Lock Embroidery Professional. Enter the letters needed to add the personalization of your team or group.
10. Hoop Cut-Away stabilizer and the cap on the cap frame using the mounting jig for positioning. This hoop is designed specifically to embroider on caps without requiring the cap to be disassembled or flattened. Remember to center the desired design placement area within the embroidery field.
11. Embroider the design using your favorite embroidery thread colors.
12. Once the embroidery design is complete, remove it from the hoop and trim away the excess stabilizer.

Flat Frame:



Supplies:

Baby Lock Embroidery Professional embroidery machine
Baby Lock Leisure Sports design collection (BLDP-P54)
Flat Frame 7 7/8" x 11 3/4" (BMP-FF)
Purchased golf towel

Baby Lock Dissolve-Away Mesh stabilizer
Various colors of embroidery thread



Instructions:

13. Select a design from the Baby Lock design collection.



14. Save the design and transfer it to your embroidery machine using your preferred method (i.e. memory card, floppy disk, direct transfer or flash drive).
15. Hoop Dissolve-Away Mesh stabilizer in the Flat Frame. This hoop is designed to help embroider items such as towels, blankets and quilts. It keeps the item laying flat and flowing over the embroidery frame brackets without the item having to awkwardly fit between the embroidery frame bracket and the base of the machine resulting in less chance of the item being disturbed during the embroidery process.
16. Lightly mist the stabilizer with temporary machine spray adhesive. Hoop the towel centering the desired design placement area within the embroidery field.
17. Embroider the design using your favorite embroidery thread colors.
18. Once the embroidery design is complete, remove it from the hoop, trim away the excess stabilizer.

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
