





Create a Cupcake Using Built-in Shapes in IQ Designer


1. Open IQ Designer.

2. Touch the Stamp Key .

3. Select closed shapes .


4. Choose the house . Ok.

5. Click on the Select  and drag a box around the most of the house, leaving the roof intact.


6. Touch cut  to easily remove the selected area.

7. The remaining unwanted lines can be removed by using the zoom feature, the preview window and eraser.

8. Zoom in 800%. Navigate the red box in the preview window to see the area that needs erasing.

















9. Select the  and choose the small square eraser. Erase the unwanted lines. Zoom back to 100%.

10. Click on the Select  and drag a box around the roof.

11. Engage  and rotate 180°. Move towards the bottom of the design page. Ok.



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12. Click  and use  to make it narrower. Ok.
13. Touch the Stamp Key .
14. Select basic shapes . Select the flower . Ok.
15. Click  and resize proportionally smaller .
16. Move it up and away from the cupcake liner.
17. Click on the Select  and drag a box around the bottom two petals.
18. Touch cut  to easily remove the selected area.
19. Open Line Property Menu  Select the line .
20. Choose the no sew line .
21. Draw a horizontal line in the open area between the icing and the liner.
22. Click on the Select  and drag a box around the line and move it to the bottom of the icing, closing the shape.
23. Let's fill the shapes.
24. Open the Region Fill Menu .
25. Select the Decorative fills .
26. Select pattern #006 and the color green.
27. Use the cup key  to pour the stitches in the liner.

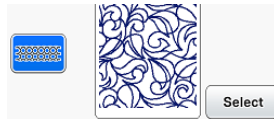


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28. Open the Region Fill Menu



29. Select the Decorative fills



30. Select pattern #003 and the color blue.

31. Use the cup key



to pour the stitches in the icing.

32. Open Line Property Menu



33. Select the bean stitch



and the color green. Ok.

34. Use the cup key



. Touch the liner outline.

35. Open Line Property Menu



36. Select the candlewicking stitch
and the color blue. Ok.



37. Use the cup key



. Touch the icing outline.


38. Click on the Select



and drag a box around the icing and merge it with the liner.




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39. Create the candle. Touch the Stamp Key .

40. Select basic shapes . Select the square. OK.

41. Resize as desired to create a rectangle for the candle. Move it to within one stitch above the icing. Ok.

42. Create the flame. Touch the Stamp Key .

43. Select basic shapes . Select the flame .

44. Resize as desired. Move it to within one stitch above the candle. Ok.

45. Open Line Property Menu .

46. Select the bean stitch  and the color yellow. Ok.

47. Use the cup key . Touch the flame outline.

48. Open Line Property Menu .

49. Select the bean stitch  and the color pink. Ok.

50. Use the cup key . Touch the candle outline.

51. Open the Region Fill Menu .



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52. Select the Decorative fills



53. Select pattern #007 and the color pink. Ok.

54. Use the cup key



to pour the stitches in the candle.

55. Open the Region Fill Menu



56. Select a color yellow and a fill stitch



. Ok.

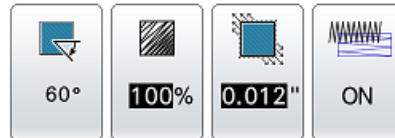
57. Use the cup key



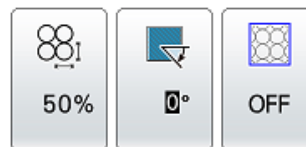
to pour the stitches in the flame.

58. Click  to assign the attributes

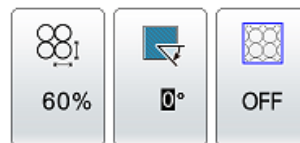
59. With the flame highlighted, set the attributes as shown. Press Set to apply.



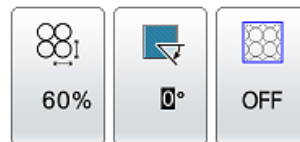
60. Select the candle and set the attributes as shown. Press Set to apply.



61. Select the icing and set the attributes as shown. Press Set to apply.



62. Select the liner and set the attributes as shown. Press Set to apply.




63. Open the Setting icon




and turn to page 8. Change the inches to millimeters.Ok.



64. Select the icing outline and leave the attributes at the default settings.

65. Select the liner outline and then the chain link icon 

66. Set the Run pitch to 2.5 . Press Set to apply.

67. Touch Preview

68. OK

69. Set

70. OK to Embroidery Edit

71. Touch Embroidery and stitch!



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
