






- 3. Select the line drawing tool
- 4. Draw a vertical line on the design page to the desired length.
- 5. **Tip**: An easy way to draw a straight line is to click on the stamp key Select Basic shapes

. On page 9, set the machine to metric. OK 9. Open Settings




11. Set both the candlewicking size and spacing to 10mm as shown. Press OK to apply.



- 12. Press Set and OK which sends it over to the embroidery edit screen.
- 13. With the candlewicking stitch highlighted, touch




Move 14. Touch and center the design



From the drop-down menu, choose the copy/duplicate key 15. Touch



- 16. Change the color of the duplicated one by touching and choosing a new color. OK
- 17. Merge the two designs so they are alternating as shown OK
