



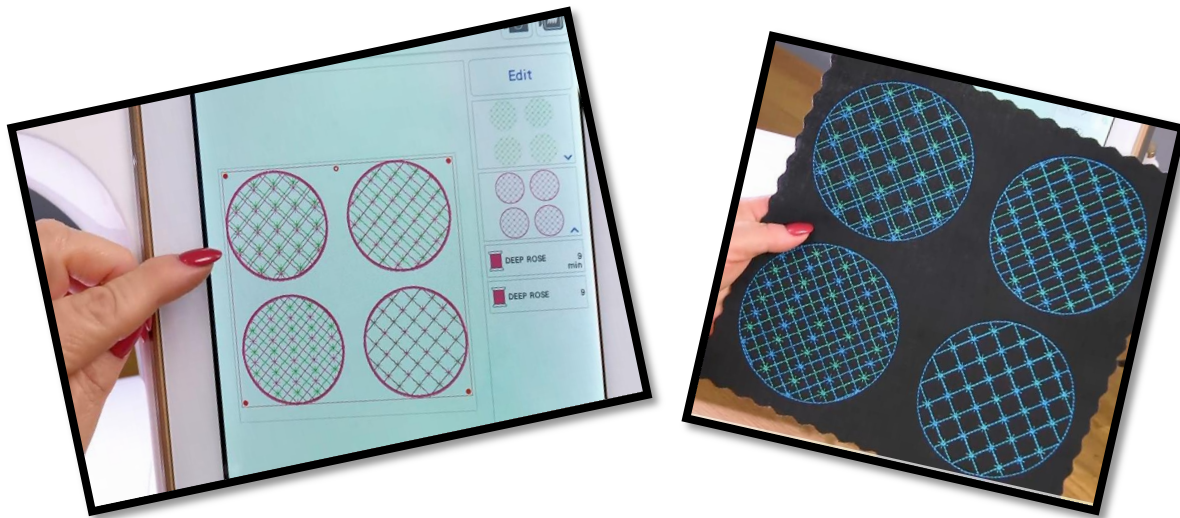











## IQ Designer – Positioning Offset with the Decorative Fills

### Instructions:

1. Open Settings  Turn to page 9; choose inches. On page 8, select embroidery frame  9-1/2" x  9-1/2" OK.
2. Open .
3. Click on the stamp key .
4. Select Basic shapes  and choose the circle (first design on the third row) .OK
5. Touch  and resize proportionally smaller  until it is 4" x 4" . OK.





6. Use the positioning arrows  to move the circle to the upper left hand corner of the 9.5 x 9.5 hoop. OK.

7. With the circle still selected, touch the copy .


8. Move the second one in the upper right corner.


9. Touch copy and move the circle to the lower left corner.


10. Touch copy and move the circle to the lower right corner.


11. There are now four circles on the screen all within the 9.5 x 9.5 hoop.

12. Save this to Memory . 

13. Open the Region Property menu .

14. Select the Decorative fills tab .

15. Touch Select and choose # 016  and a color. OK


16. Touch the cup key  and touch inside each of the four circles. 

17. Open the Line Property menu  Select the No Sew icon  OK 

18. Touch the cup key  and touch the outline of the four circles. 

19. Open Settings  Turn to page 9; choose metric.

20. Touch .

21. One circle is highlighted. Since the same attributes will be applied to all circles, link them together by touching the chain link icon .

22. All circles are highlighted. Adjust the settings as shown below. Press OK after each change.

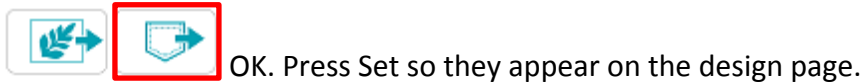




23. Touch Set and OK.



25. Open IQ Designer Retrieve the 4 circles from Memory Recall.



26. Open the Region Property menu

27. Select the Decorative fills tab

28. Touch Select and choose # 016 and a color.

29. Touch the cup key and touch inside each of the four circles.

30. Open the Line Property menu

31. Select a color and the satin stitch

32. Touch the cup key and touch the outline of the four circles.

33. Open Settings . On page 9, set the machine to metric.

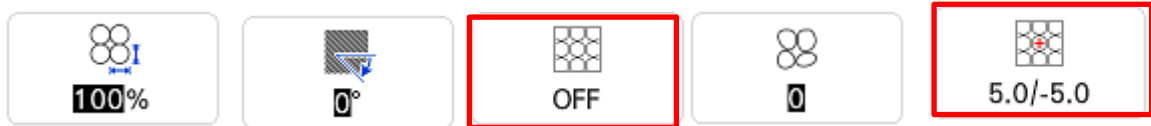
34. Touch

35. The circle in the upper left corner is highlighted. Adjust the settings as shown below. Press OK after each change.





36. Touch the circle in the upper right corner and make the adjustments as shown. Press OK after each change.




37. Touch the circle in the lower left corner and make the adjustments as shown. Press OK after each change.



38. Touch the circle in the lower right corner and make the adjustments as shown. Press OK after each change.




39. Touch the outline of one of the circles. Since the same attributes will be applied to all circles, link them together by touching the chain link icon .

40. All circles are highlighted. Leave the satin stitch attributes at their default settings as shown below.






41. Touch Set and OK.

42. Group the design elements together before moving on the screen. Press .

43. Touch  and the screen will change to pink. Touch OK.



44. Touch  and then Group .
45. Once the design is grouped it can be moved on the design page as desired.
46. Touch  and stitch the design!
