

Troubleshooting Regalia and Pro-Stitcher on the Kinetic Frame

Regalia and Pro-Stitcher

- 1. Managing Cords Video Time Mark :30
 - a. Pro-Stitcher power cord has a filter box attached to the cord.
 - b. Seat Cords tight
 - c. Silver cord holders need to be attached
 - i. Lock cords in place
 - ii. Do not leave these off the cord
 - 1. Cords vibrate and can fall out of machine
 - 2. Some of these silver clips are attached and some you will attach
 - d. Plug into a ground serge protector
 - i. Protect your machine when leaving by removing the plugs from wall
 - ii. Battery backup serger protector is good to have in areas where you experience power outages often
 - e. Keep cords out of the way
 - i. X encoder left to right
 - ii. Y encoder front to back
 - f. Machine should be off when plugging thing in and out
- 2. Powering Up Video Time Mark 2:15
 - a. 20" machine has two power switches
 - b. If you are leaving machine for an extended period of time power down with the rear switch
 - c. Light turns blue with power
 - d. It takes 30 seconds for the machine to cycle on and play the music
 - e. Load fabric taunt not tight or you may experience skipped stitches
 - f. Needle should be up when turning on Pro-Stitcher
 - g. Turn on Pro-Stitcher
 - i. You may need to hold the button for a few seconds when power is being turned on
 - ii. Keep machine still when powering on Pro-Stitcher







- h. Machine Needle
 - i. Fully rounded needle
 - ii. Eye forward front to back
 - iii. Curve of needle in front
 - iv. Groove in front
 - v. Packages
 - 1. 134
 - 2. R regular point needle
 - 3. 100/16 most used
 - 4. FG ball point needle
 - 5. 125/20 larger needle
 - vi. Sizes very from 80/12 being the smallest to 125/20 the largest
- 3. Pro-Stitcher has two functions
 - i. One being the screen to the Regalia
 - ii. Top gray rectangle once touch brings up 5 icons
 - 1. Red X Closes icons
 - 2. Keyboard icon
 - 3. BL Regalia Screen
 - 4. PS Pro-Stitcher Screen
 - 5. Art and Stitch Last icon on the right
 - iii. Click on BL to open the Regalia Screen
 - 1. Handwheel on Screen
 - a. Makes it easy to reach on 20" machine
 - b. Only turn the direction of arrow
 - i. Do not roll backward
 - ii. Drag finger on screen to move handwheel
 - c. Use needle up/down button on handles to put the needle in the correct position
 - You can use the on screen handwheel to move the needle to the highest position when using the Glide Foot. It makes it easier to thread.
- 4. Updating Pro-Stitcher Video Time Mark 6:12
 - a. USB stick
 - i. Format before using
 - ii. Find stick location on computer









- iii. Formatting with right mouse click
 - 1. Dropdown menu
 - 2. Click on FAT
 - 3. Click on Start
 - 4. Everything on your stick will be erased
- iv. Clear screen
- v. ? will take you to the ABOUT
 - 1. This is open an information window with your Pro-Stitcher
 - 2. Listing
 - a. Version
 - b. Key
 - c. License
 - d. Mode
 - e. Machine
 - f. Motor
 - 3. Go to Babylock.com
 - a. Support
 - b. Pro-Stitcher
 - c. Download update and put on USB stick
 - 4. Place USB stick in one of the 2 ports on the Pro-Stitcher bracket
 - 5. Document will download with update
 - a. Print
 - b. Read
 - c. Update
 - 6. Update
 - a. When turning on Pro-Stitcher the program looks for updates found on stick
 - b. You can also update under File
 - i. Update
 - ii. Click on USB stick
 - iii. Select update
 - iv. Run
 - c. You do need to click steps while updating
 - 7. Rail/bar heights







- a. Position changes for machine with and without Pro-Stitcher
- b. The Idle bar should be just about the bed of the machine
- c. Check to make sure the update took on your Pro-Stitcher
 - i. Under ABOUT
 - ii. Or on the Regalia Screen
- 5. Threading Video Time Mark 11:54
 - a. Good Quality Thread
 - b. Follow along not skipping any holes on your machine
 - c. Floss when putting in tensions
 - d. Spring shows it is in the correct position
 - e. Take up lever
 - f. Down to needle not missing any placement
 - g. Threading needle
 - i. You may want to shut laser light off
 - 1. Found on Regalia screen
 - 2. On and off switch
 - ii. Needle up down to pull up bobbin thread
 - iii. Tie off to test stitching
 - 1. Tie off was programed for the diamond icon on the right handle of the Regalia
 - 2. You can also use tie off icon on the Regalia screen
 - h. Testing X and Y Encoders Video Time Mark 14:23
 - i. X left to right
 - ii. Y forward to back
 - iii. Look at back of quilt to check stitching
 - iv. Tighten the tension
 - 1. Right to tighten
 - 2. Think of a clock
 - a. Turn 30 mins. On a clock dial
 - b. Check again looking at back
 - c. Do this if you see the top thread coming through the bobbin







- i. Changing threads
 - i. You can tie off the threads
 - ii. Pull through the machine
 - iii. Pull above the needle
 - iv. Rethread the needle
- 6. Encoders Video Time Mark 17:13
 - a. Testing encoders
 - i. X left to right
 - ii. Y front to back
 - iii. Release gears
 - 1. Pro-Stitcher Icon
 - 2. Click on gears
 - a. When the gear icon is purple you are in free hand quilting
 - b. When the gear is orange you are in record
 - i. Motors are stiff
 - ii. Partway engaged for recording
 - 3. Test
 - 4. X direction
 - a. Needle moves up and down stitching looks good
 - b. Needle is controlled by encoders
 - 5. Y direction
 - a. Machine is skipping stitches
 - b. Need to check Y encoder
 - i. Found on rear of carriage and frame
 - ii. Check
 - 1. Threads in wheel
 - 2. Wheel is inContact with frame
 - 3. Is wheel turning?
 - 4. Is the encoder plugged in?
- 7. Checking Carriage Video Time Mark 19:24
 - a. Rocking carriage can cause skipped stitches
 - b. Tipping carriage
 - i. Screws and track need adjusting
 - ii. 4 wheels should touch track







- 8. Advanced Pro-Stitcher Settings Video Time Mark 20:12
 - a. Warning do not take your tablet on the internet
 - i. You will void your warranty
 - ii. Updating your Pro-Stitcher to get your Windows updates
 - b. Tablet Settings
 - i. All settings
 - ii. Systems
 - 1. Rotation lock needs to be on
 - 2. Search to find if you need to
 - 3. Turn volume up to hear clicks
 - 4. Sleep mode
 - a. Never on
 - b. You do not want to have the tablet stop when you are quilting
 - c. Advanced Setting of the Pro-Stitcher
 - i. Customize and settings can be changed
 - 1. General
 - a. Simulation mode
 - b. Us the tablet in a non-stitch mode
 - 2. Communication
 - a. Connections and reconnect
 - i. Motors
 - ii. Machine
 - b. Use these when you get a motor error
 - c. Motor errors happen for many reasons
 - i. Turning machine and PS off in wrong order
 - ii. Running into the rails
 - ii. Speed profile
 - 1. 64 default
 - 2. 2500 stitch per min default settings
 - 3. Logging
 - a. Debug
 - b. Normal
 - c. Minimum
 - 4. Motor torque Regalia 200-250 settings







- iii. Motor errors
 - 1. Hitting the rails or machine
 - 2. Pinched cords
 - 3. Cord unplugged
- 9. New Start and End Points with Pro-Stitcher Video Time Mark 28:16
 - a. Bobbin runs out or thread breaks how do we get back
 - b. Stitching design
 - i. Thread breaks
 - ii. Touch pause on lower left corner of Pro-Stitcher Tablet
 - iii. Or you may have your thread sensor on and the machine will alarm and let you know it has issues with thread
 - iv. Click on Pro-Stitcher icon
 - v. Machine error may appear with thread break sensor
 - vi. Backing up
 - 1. Click on Pro-Stitcher icon and new start/end point
 - 2. Move machine to position you want to restart
 - 3. Click on auto to view where start moves to the location of needle
 - 4. Double click to lock in the new start point
- 10. Shutting Down Video Time Mark 31:55
 - a. Click on file
 - b. Click on shut down
 - c. Click on shut down
 - d. You may be asked if you want to save design
 - e. Blue screen is shut down screen
 - f. Now turn machine off
 - i. Front button
 - ii. Back button can stay on but not for long periods of time
 - iii. Back of machine switch is for when you leave the machine for a long period of time
 - iv. The Pro-Stitcher will still be on with the rear on off switch not being shut down
