1. Lesson – Sawtooth Block
 - a. Open PS or BL-Sawtooth Star
 - i. The design selected can be stitch for learning purposes
 - ii. We will use it for our quilt block
 - b. Open PS or BL-Square
 - i. Set the square in a 2-corner area
 - ii. Make a square area
 - iii. Click Modify
 - iv. Skew
 - v. Skew 1
 - c. Click on Sawtooth Star
 - i. Click Modify
 - ii. Skew
 - iii. Skew 1
 - d. Click Baseline
 - e. Setting design in the area of the Sawtooth Star Block



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- f. Open the Curly Block
 - i. On point design
 - ii. Good for the center block
 - iii. Set area
 - 1. Click Area
 - 2. Move needle to the first corner
 - 3. Click MultiPoint
 - 4. Line the needle in the same position for each corner.
 - iv. Click on Modify
 - 1. Click on Skew
 - 2. Skew 1
 - v. Click Baseline
 - vi. Clear area
- g. You can stitch the Area
 - i. Found on the sidebar on the right side of the screen
 - ii. Boundary and Area can be stitched
 - iii. Baseline
- h. Edit and Duplicate
 - i. Click on Edit
 - ii. Click on Duplicate
- i. Move design dragging to the side
- j. Analyze the design
 - i. Could be a triangle
 - ii. How can we split a design?
- k. You can make an area and crop inside
- l. Move the needle to where you want to split
 - i. Pro-Stitcher
 - ii. Click on Start End Point
 - iii. Click on Auto end twice
 - iv. Click on modify
 - v. Click on crop
 - vi. Click on start/end point
 - vii. You can move through the design to see how it stitches
- m. Set area for putting the triangle in
 - i. Click on Area
 - ii. Click on Multipoint
 - iii. Click on Modify
 - 1. Click on Skew
 - 2. Click on Triangle Skew
 - iv. Areas have the same property as a design
 - v. Repeat in each of the corner triangles



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- n. An Area can be cleared once the design is Baseline
- o. Duplicate triangle design
 - i. Refresh to zoom in
 - ii. Lower right corner house icon
- p. Looking at the design we can get another triangle from the split design
 - i. Move the points to crop what you would like
 - ii. Don't forget to save early and save often
- q. Set the new triangle in the points of the star

 - 2. Skew Triangle
 - iv. Repeat for all of the flying geese

- 2. Lesson 20" Block Kimmy Burnner – Feathered Heart
 - a. You cannot stitch a 20" block on an 18-20" machine without splitting
 - b. ½ Design in center of the block
 - c. Set 4 point/multi point area
 - d. Rotate 45 degrees
 - e. Start and end point are split
 - i. One on top
 - ii. Other on bottom of design
 - iii. Move through the design to find how it stitches
 - f. Modify
 - i. Crop
 - ii. Start and end point
 - iii. You can adjust as needed
 - iv. Baseline
 - g. Stitch 1st half
 - i. Before stitching
 - ii. Swap start end point
 - h. Edit
 - i. Duplicate
 - ii. Set design below the 1st half
 - i. Stitch 1st half
 - i. Put needle in the down position
 - ii. Drag and drop to reposition the design

 - a. Set the split design in the top triangle

 - i. Set BL Block Feather Triangle
