 - a) C2S – Edit file format
 - b) Library files

 - e) TT – True Type Fonts
 - f) Save formats are not the same as import or open
 - g) Pro-Stitcher reads more than 6 formats HQF is one
- 7) Lesson 3 opening an Embroidery Design
 - a) Open
 - b) Click on file save as and its now a quilting design
- 8) Lesson 4 Free Hand drawing
 - a) Select all
 - i) Right mouse click
 - ii) Click smooth
 - iii) Adjust each node as needed
 - b) Rotate to put start and stop on same horizon line
 - c) Repeat
 - i) 6 across
 - ii) 6 down
 - iii) Flip
 - (1) Horizontal
 - (2) Vertical
 - iv) You will play until you like what you created.
