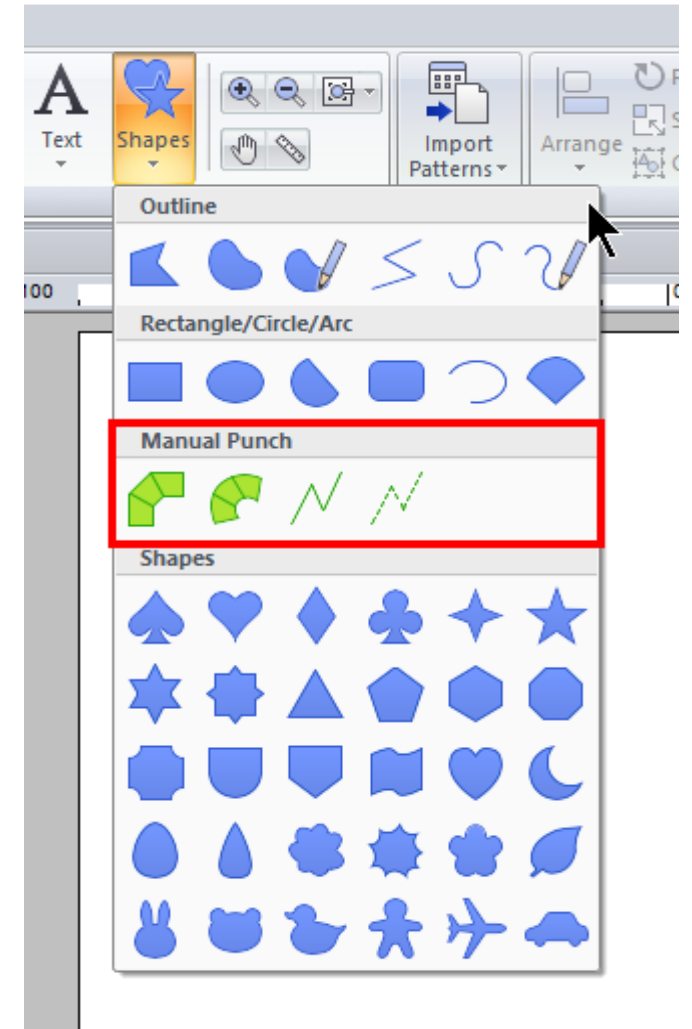
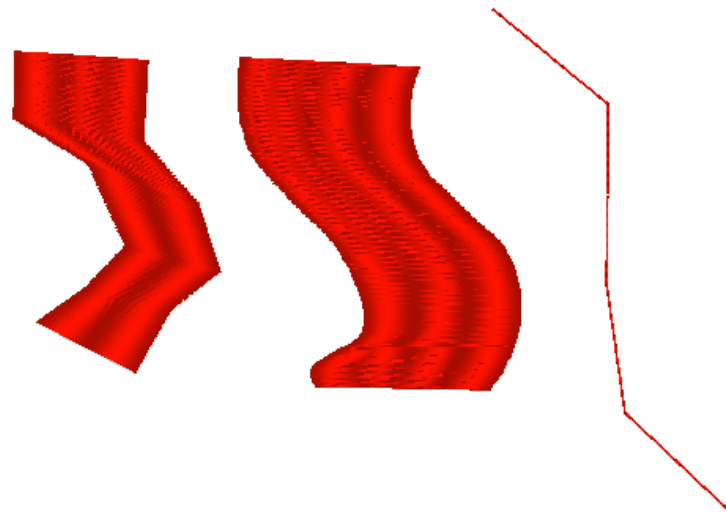
Punch It Up!

- ▶ **What is manual punch?**
 - ▶ **Stitches that are placed manually. As opposed to using the fill shape tool, where an area is flooded with stitches at the click of the mouse; manually punched stitches are placed one at time or by groups so you can get precise placement.**
- ▶ **How are they used?**
 - ▶ **They are used in areas that require a more exact or precise placement of stitches.**

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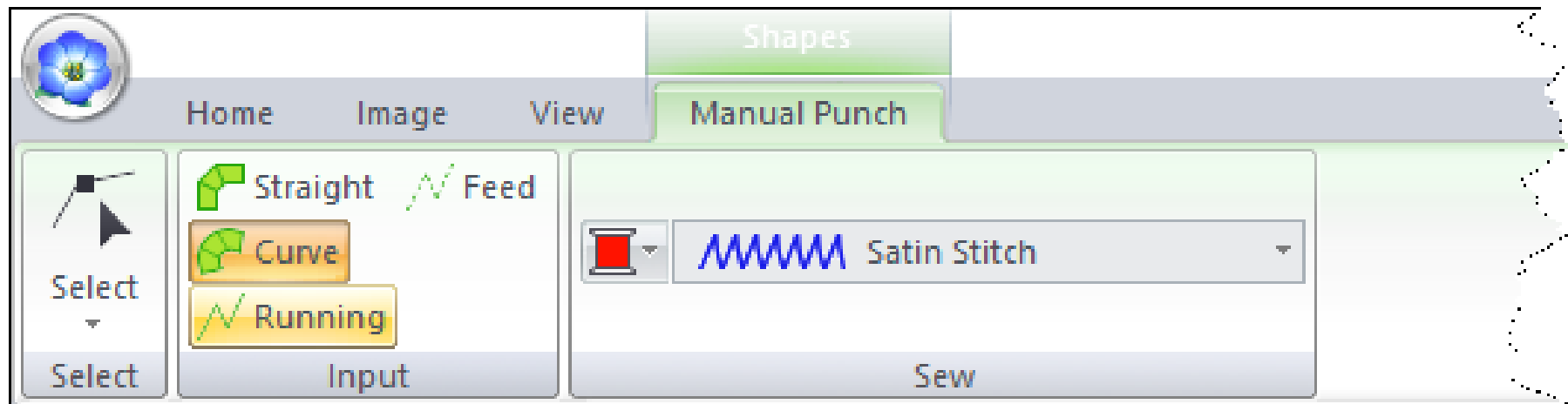
► What are the manual punch tools in Palette?

- Straight Block – Region sewing (Z)
- Curved Block – Region sewing (X)
- Running – Line sewing (V)
- Feed – Jump stitches (B)



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- ▶ **What are the manual punch tools in Palette?**
 - ▶ **The Shapes tab changes to the Manual Punch tab**
 - ▶ **Manual Punch can be used with a variety of stitches**
 - ▶ **Editing can be done to the nodes and the stitch direction**

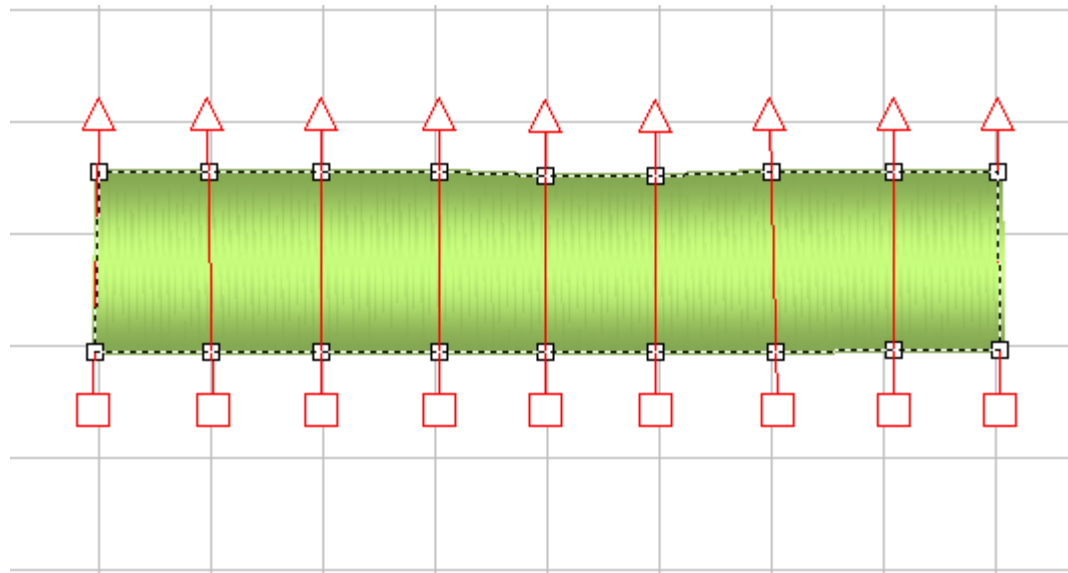


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- ▶ **How to use manual punch stitches:**
 - ▶ **To contour a small area**
 - ▶ **To add highlights or lowlights**
 - ▶ **To make embroidery fringe**

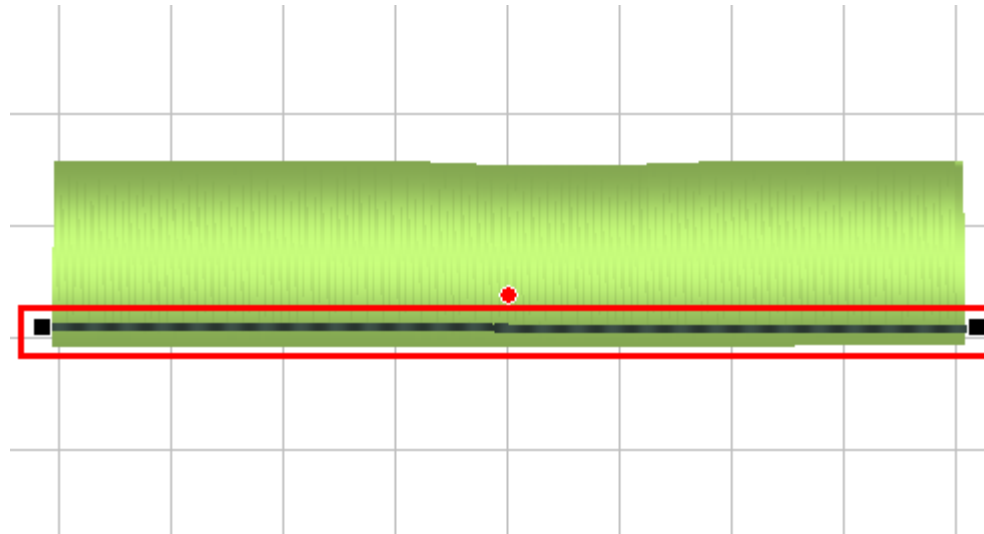
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- ▶ **Let's create embroidery fringe...**
 - ▶ **Using the Straight block manual punch tool, create a block of stitches. Be mindful that most machines can only create 6-10mm stitch while creating the block of stitches.**



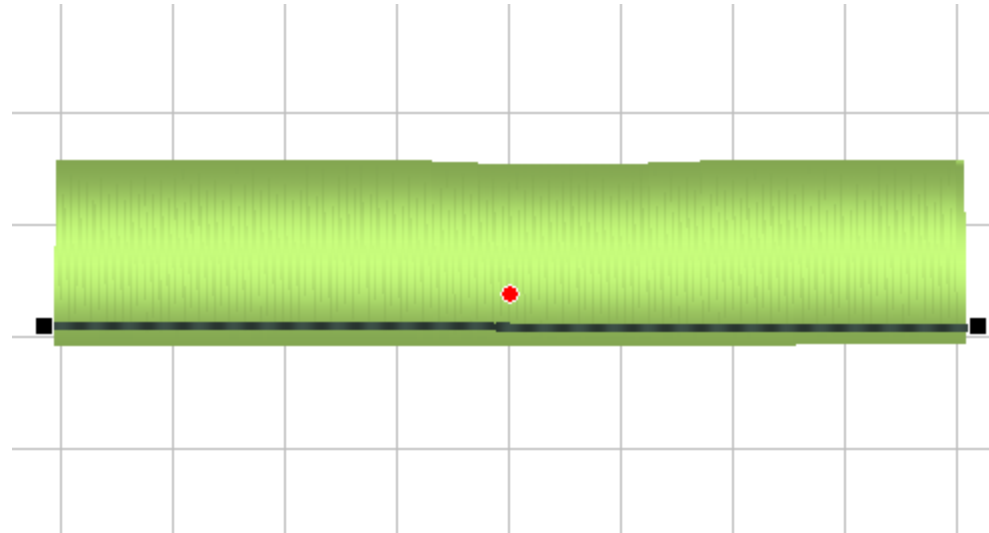
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- ▶ **Let's create embroidery fringe...continued**
 - ▶ **Using the Open Straight Line tool, create line of running stitches at the bottom of the manual punch stitches. Apply a triple run to these stitches.**



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- ▶ **Let's create embroidery fringe...continued**
 - ▶ **Now, it's ready to save and stitch. Stitch this on your machine with stabilizer. When finished, cut the bobbin thread from the manual punch stitches and pull them to the front and waa-laa!**



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
