1. Lesson 1: Overview of Designs built into the ANS Library
 - a. Open Block Patterns
 - i. Theo's Heart
 1. Build the heart as a pincushion
 2. Pre-quilt fabrics and cut into heart
 3. Add the heart in open space on the frame with other projects
 - ii. Stitch about 4"
 - iii. Fill with walnut shells, sawdust or whatever works for you
 - iv. Repeat the heart across the fabric on the frame to make for all your friends
 - v. The back is pieced and hand stitched shut
 - vi. Give yourself enough space for seam allowance
 - b. Open Creative Fills
 - i. Mini Bag
 - ii. Open stipple design
 1. Repeat



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- 2. You only need one repeat on the USB stick and repeat at the Pro-Stitcher
- iii. Great way to make pre-quilted fabrics
- iv. There are many fills that can be repeated but you will also find some do not repeat
- c. Designer Collection
 - i. Designs may have a video associated with it. Go to artandstitch.com for video tutorials
 - ii. Open Father Christmas
 - 1. Placemat
 - 2. Pillow
 - 3. This design has 2 parts
 - a. Frame
 - b. center
 - iii. Open Dragon
 - 1. Quilt fabric
 - 2. Great design for boys
 - 3. Whole cloth quilt repeated across
 - 4. Wrap and offset
 - 5. You can also mirror second row
 - iv. Open Michelle's all over design
 - 1. Rainforest style design
 - 2. You will see more things the more you look at it
 - 3. Whole cloth piece
 - 4. Pre-quilted fabrics
- 2. Lesson 2 Feathers
 - a. Round table trivet for a table
 - b. You will need to use bias binding
 - c. Create the piece the size you need with the Pro-Stitcher
 - i. You can make a perfect circle with the shapes key holding the ctrl key
 - ii. The circle can be stitched and used to cut or sew line

Questions from live session

Back is a false back with quilting. You add the back to the piece when it is off the frame.

- d. Feather in Hexi
 - i. Resize
 - ii. Rotate
- 3. Lesson 3 Judy Allen Feather
 - a. Build a frame with her feathers
 - b. Duplicate
 - c. Rotate
 - d. Making a frame for placemats
 - e. Place crosshatch in center



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- f. Add a shape around the frame
 - g. Save early save often
 - i. Ans format for edits
 - ii. Save for your machine
 - iii. HQF Pro-Stitcher
 - 1. Need to add stitch segments to design
 - 2. Line stitch type running
 - 4. Lesson 4 layout templates
 - a. Scallop placemat
 - b. Fill the center and make a placemat or runner
 - c. Table runner to build with
 - i. Set designs in the squares
 - ii. Set design with nothing
 - iii. Set design with center blocks only
 - 5. Lesson 5 TrueType Fonts
 - a. Pre-built truetype fonts
 - i. Each letter is a design
 - ii. Set these as a saying in the frame
 - iii. Setting letters, you still have them in the font folder of ANS
 - b. You can also bring in your own fonts
 - c. Basic shapes
 - i. Sewing quilt block
 - ii. Set designs in the areas
 - iii. Place sewing machine in frame
 - 1. Great sewing machine pad
 - 2. Protects table machine may be on
 - 3. Add as many shapes as you would like
 - d. You also have the ability to make cut files
