Border Guide Foot

(BLDY-BGF)

Instructions

Easily match up your border designs with the red lines on the Border Guide Foot. You no longer need to mark every row beforehand!


MACHINE SETTINGS

Stitch type:	Utility or Decorative Stitches
Stitch width:	Maximum 7mm

Two sets of vertical red lines are calibrated to allow perfect spacing. The horizontal line matches the needle drop point and the small red mark shows the design's center, lining up with the first row's marking.

- Mark your first row and where each row will start. Match the horizontal red line and the center red mark. Sew the first row
- Match the first row between the two red lines on one side of the foot. Skip the second row sew the third row of your design.

Note: By skipping a row, the first row stays clear of the feed dogs so you are not sewing on an uneven surface that could cause your stitching to veer off course.



- 3. Sew the second middle row, matching the outside rows inside the two inner red lines on each side of the foot.
- 4. Add additional rows by jumping ahead a row and then returning to the middle row.
