## EMBROIDERED PILLOW

Embroidery can be fun no matter what age! Elaina is 12 years old and will show us how to make her favorite project, PILLOWS!

- Baby Lock sewing and embroidery machine
- Embroidery hoop
- 2 pieces of fabric, cut to desired measurements
- Baby Lock Tear-away Stabilizer #BLT103
- Madeira Embroidery Thread
- Pillow stuffing
- Hand-sewing needle

1 Hoop your fabric and stabilizer. You can use a 4" x 4" or 5"x7" hoop.

2 Type in the word, name, or phrase and set it to fit the screen.

3 Size, rotate, and position as desired.

4 Stitch out your design with your desired thread color.

5 Take the hoop off the machine and the fabric out of the hoop.

6 Place the front and back sides of your pillow, pretty sides together.

7 Using your sewing machine, stitch around the entire perimeter of your pillow, leaving a 4-5" opening. Clip the corners of your pillow to remove any bulk.

8 Turn your pillow right side out, stuff it, and hand stitch the opening closed.
