## Modern Quilt with Embroidery Medallions



The best of both worlds, embroidery and quilting! This modern quilt was created on the Baby Lock Aurora, featuring the built-in embroidery designs and a decorative stitch that was used for the quilting.

Skill Level: Beginner
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## Supplies:

- Baby Lock Aurora Embroidery and Sewing Machine
- Baby Lock Tear-Away Stabilizer, 4 pieces 8" x 8"
- Tula Pink Linework Paper White Fabric, $3 / 4$ yard
- Tula Pink Linework Ink Black Fabric, 3/4 yard
- Tula Pink Linework Mineral Paper Fabric, 1 12 yard
- Moda Grunge Red Fabric, $1 / 4$ yard
- Madeira Red Rayon Embroidery Thread

- Madeira Cotona 50wt Thread for piecing
- Quilter's Dream Crib size batting 36 " $\times 45$ "


## Preparations:

From the Baby Lock Tear-Away Stabilizer:

- 4 pieces 8 " $\times 8$ "

From the Tula Pink Linework Paper White, Fabric A, $3 / 4$ yard, cut the following:

- 1 piece $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 4 pieces $8^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces 12.5 " $\times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces $18.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $26.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $28.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece 4.5 " $\times 2.5$ "

From the Tula Pink Linework Ink Black, Fabric B, $3 / 4$ yard, cut the following:

- 9 pieces $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces $18.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $26.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $28.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces 36.5 " $\times 2$ "

From the Tula Pink Linework Mineral Paper, Fabric C, $1^{1 ⁄ 2}$ yard, cut the following:

- 9 pieces $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5$ "
- 2 pieces $18.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $26.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 piece $28.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces $32.5^{\prime \prime} \times 1.5^{\prime \prime}$
- 2 pieces $36.5^{\prime \prime} \times 1.5$ "
- 1 piece 36 " $\times$ WOF for backing

From the Moda Grunge Red, Fabric D, $1 / 4$ yard, cut the following:

- 3 pieces 36.5 " x 1.5 "


## Instructions:

## Embroidery:

1. Layer the 8 " $\times 8$ " Fabric A on top of stabilizer, and hoop, centering both layers.
2. Press the Embroidery Icon, then press Exclusive, then press Freehand.
3. Stitch out 2 of Design 003 and 2 of Design 004, creating a total of 4 units; using the Madeira Red Rayon Embroidery
 Thread.
4. Using a $6.5 " \times 6.5$ " square ruler, center the design under the ruler and trim excess fabric leaving you a 6.5 " x 6.5 " embroidered square. Repeat for all 4 of the units.


## Piecing:

1. Take 2 each of Fabric B and C, 2.5 " $\times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ and place on the embroidered unit's corners.
2. Sew Diagonally Corner to Corner of the 2.5 " $\times 2.5$ " square, creating a half square triangle in each of the 4 corners of the embroidered block.
3. Trim $1 / 4$ " from seam, press open. Repeat for remaining blocks.

4. With the remaining 2.5 " squares from Fabrics $A, B$, and $C$, sew them together creating a unit that measures $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$. Make 1 unit.

5. Sew the $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5$ " rectangles together, from Fabrics $A, B$, and $C$, along the 4.5 " length, resulting in a unit that measures 4.5 " $\times 6.5$ ". Make 1 unit.

6. Sew the 12.5 " $\times 2.5$ " strips together from Fabrics A, B, and C, along the 12.5 " length, resulting in a unit that measures 12.5 " $\times 6.5$ ". Make 2 units.

7. Sew the 18.5 " $\times 2.5$ " strips together from Fabrics A, B, and C, along the $18.5^{\text {" length, }}$ resulting in a unit that measures 18.5 " x 6.5 ". Make 2 units.

8. Sew the $26.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips together from Fabrics A, B, and C, along the $26.5^{\text {" length, }}$ resulting in a unit that measures $26.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$. Make 1 unit.

9. Sew the 28.5 " $\times 2.5$ " strips together from Fabrics $A, B$, and C, along the 28.5 " length, resulting in a unit that measures 28.5 " $\times 6.5$ ". Make 1 unit.


## Next, we are going to create 4 large units.

10. Sew 12.5 " $\times 6.5$ " to the top of one of the embroidered 6.5 " $\times 6.5$ ", and then sew 18.5 " x $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ unit to the bottom of embroidered unit. This unit should measure $36.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5$ ". Make 1 unit (A).

11. Sew 26.5 " x 6.5 " to the top of one of the embroidered 6.5 " x 6.5 ", and then sew 4.5 " x $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ unit to the bottom of embroidered unit. This unit should measure $36.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5$ ". Make 1 unit (B).

12. Sew $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ to the top of one the embroidered $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$, and then sew $28.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ unit to the bottom of embroidered unit. This unit should measure $36.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$. Make 1 unit (C).

13. Sew 18.5 " x 6.5 " to the top of one of the embroidered 6.5 " x 6.5 ", and then sew 12.5 " $x$ 6.5 " unit to the bottom of embroidered unit. This unit should measure $36.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5$ ". Make 1 unit (D).


## Assemble as follows, from left to right:

- Grey, 36.5" x 1.5"
- Black, 36.5" x 2"
- Unit A, 36.5" x6.5"
- Red, 36.5" x $1.5^{\prime \prime}$
- Unit B, 36.5" x6.5"
- Red, $36.5^{\prime \prime} \times 1.5^{\prime \prime}$
- Unit C, 36.5" x6.5"
- Red, 36.5" x $1.5^{\prime \prime}$
- Unit D, 36.5" x6.5"
- Black, 36.5" 2 "
- Grey, 36.5" x 1.5"

Then Add Grey 32.5" x 1.5" to top and bottom.


Quilt Top is complete. Layer backing, batting and top, quilt with a walking foot in the ditch (over seamlines) with a decorative stitch. I used the Serpentine Stitch \#2-17, 5 mm width x 1 mm length. Bind quilt with Grey Mineral.
